We cordially invite Your team to take part in the second edition of Bukovytsya Open – FIS Alpine Ski Children competitions, hosted by Bukovytsia Ski Complex on January 26th – January 28th, 2022. The competitions are organized by Bukovytsia Ski Complex and Ski Federation of Ukraine with support of the City Administrations of Truskavets, Drohobych and Boryslav cities and L'viv Regional State Administration.

Registration \ Race Office

Registration will be held in the Information Center of Truskavets (Boryslavs'ka Street, 1, Truskavets). During the competition days Race Office will be located in the Bukovytsia Ski Complex.

Quotas

Total of 10 racers + 4 officials from each country. Participation above this quota has to be approved with the OC.

Accommodation

Accommodation will be provided in the nearby hotels of Truskavets.

Costs

The Organizing Committee takes over expenses for accommodation, meals, ski passes for 6 racers and 2 officials from each country from January 26th (dinner) to January 39th, 2022 (breakfast). Other team members will have 50% discount for accommodation (detailed information following the preliminary entries to info@bukovytsia.com.ua). For the teams who want to arrive before or stay after the mentioned days, for reservation by special rate you should contact the OC (info@bukovytsia.com.ua, tel.: +380939391262) before January 15th, 2022.







Transportation

The OC provides upon request the transportation to \setminus from venue and to \setminus from train station \setminus L'viv airport (LWO).

By car "Bukovytsia" can be reached through cities of: L'viv − Stryi − Truskavets. We recommend to follow boarder points Shegyni \ Korsczova (POL).

Entries

Entries to be sent using official FIS form, approval of the National Association is required. The entry forms should be sent no later than **January 15th**, **2022** to: entries@sfu.org.ua and info@bukovytsia.com.ua.

Prizes

First three places of each race will be awarded with prizes.

Equipment: according to the ICR. Respective medical and injury insurance (including transportation) is mandatory for all team members and have to be provided upon registration.

Covid-19 procedures and restrictions:

General information for entry is provided at the governmental resource https://visitukraine.today/. To the date of December 28th, 2021 the entry is allowed with no self-isolation either with one or two doses of vaccines approved by WHO or with negative PCR test not older than 72-hours. There may be requirement to pass express test oncite, which costs about 40-50 Eur depending on the laboratory. As long as the list of the countries and procedures are regularly updated we suggest to work on the arising questions in regular flow of work.
